reparative justice focuses on finding a solution a	t a large scale and implementing that solution so that it lasts so
that the communities that were harmed receive	justice. The author also suggests that while restorative justice

focuses on repairing harm, it may not adequately address the underlying systemic issues that lead to injustice.
