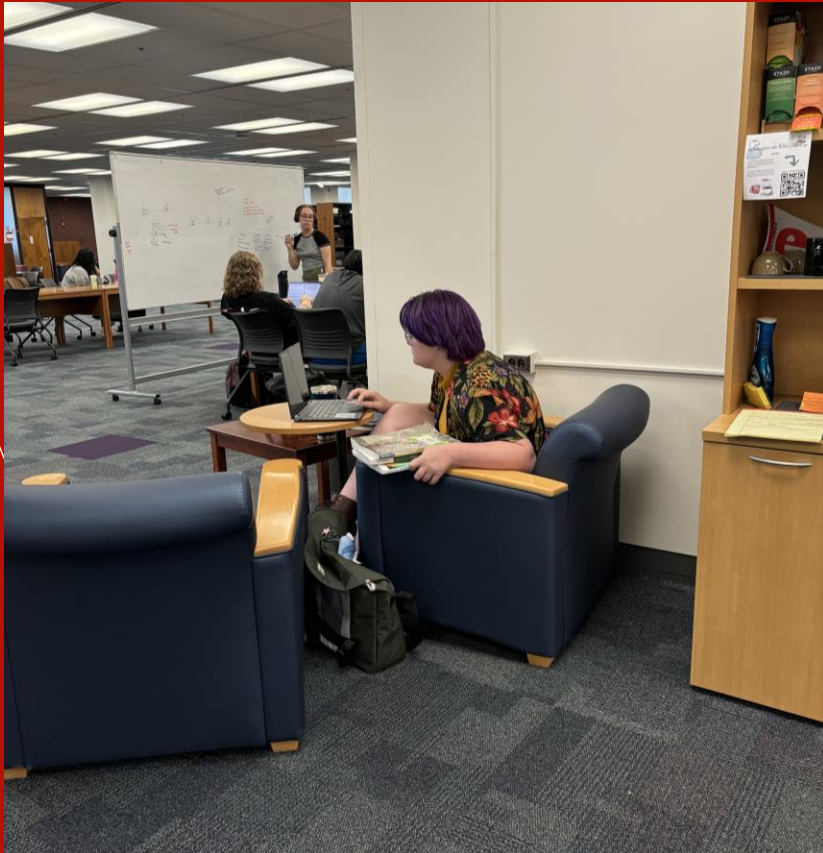


# SOUNDPROOF CUBICLE

# INTERACTING WITH YOUR PEERS IN THE COMMUNITY



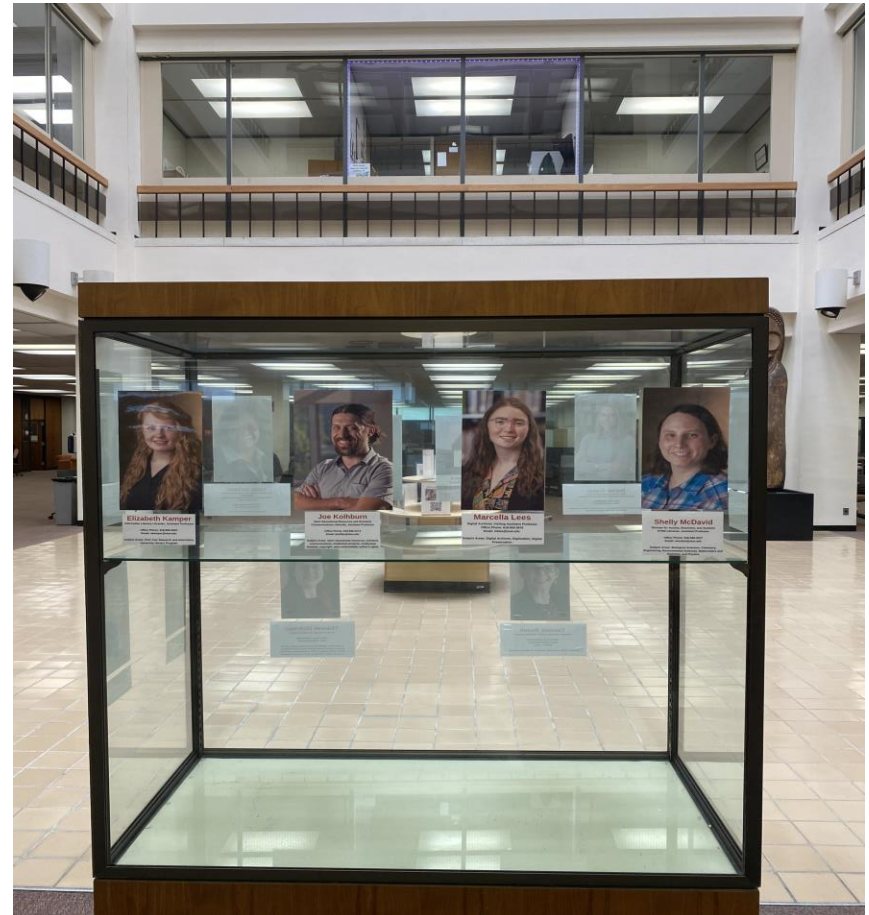
